Jonathan Nitschke was born in 1973 in Syracuse, New York, USA. He received his bachelor's degree in chemistry from Williams College in 1995, and his doctorate from the University of California, Berkeley in 2001 under the supervision of T. Don Tilley. He then undertook postdoctoral studies with Jean-Marie Lehn in Strasbourg, and in 2003 he started his independent career as a maître-assistant (independent junior PI) in the Organic Chemistry Department of the University of Geneva, where he became a Swiss National Science Foundation Assistant Professor in August 2007. Since November 2007 he has held the position of University Lecturer and Walters-Kundert Next Generation Fellow at the University of Cambridge.
